Building on the dialogue initiated in the NDC 3.0 Regional Forums, this event will delve into the best practices for identifying and integrating sectoral opportunities into the development of NDCs 3.0, highlighting the challenges and opportunities that arise when aligning various sectoral policies. The discussion will explore strategies for harmonizing efforts across sectors, ensuring that sectoral actions contribute to a cohesive and ambitious national climate strategy. The discussion will also discuss considerations and approaches for incorporating new sectors into NDCs, enhancing ambition in existing sectors, and overcoming barriers to integration. Through case studies and expert insights, attendees will gain practical guidance on crafting more comprehensive and impactful NDCs.
