

The Regional Collaboration Centre for Latin America (RCC Panama) was established in 2013 by the United Nations Framework Convention for Climate Change (UNFCCC) secretariat. It is hosted by UN Environment Programme (UNEP) regional office Panama.





RCC Panama

The RCC Panama has been established in an effort to increase the regional distribution of Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) projects by enhancing capacity building, reducing the risk for investors and providing hands-on support to governments, non-governmental organizations and businesses interested in developing CDM projects in Latin America.

After the adoption of the Paris Agreement in December 2015, the scope of the RCC's work has regionally oriented to facilitate the implementation of the Paris Agreement including the National Determined Contributions (NDCs) with a focus on mitigation, adaptation and climate finance consistent with the Sustainable Development Goals. The RCC Panama works in collaboration with UNFCCC divisions, UNEP and other partners to support governments, implementing entities, UN agencies, development banks, private sector, etc.


Opportunities for close collaboration (south-south cooperation).

Adaptation

Transparency


- Supporting efforts to provide technical assistance and training to experts engaged in the reporting, review and analysis processes of the MRV (Measurement, Reporting and Verification)

About the RCCs

UNFCCC and six prominent partners are catalysing action on the ground through regional collaboration centres combining climate change expertise with in-depth local knowledge, in Bangkok, Dubai, Kampala, Lomé, St. George's-Grenada and Panama.

Set up to spread the benefits of the Clean Development Mechanism under the Kyoto Protocol, the RCCs have broadened their role since the adoption of the Paris Agreement to facilitate the implementation of countries' Nationally Determined Contributions under that agreement.

The RCCs facilitate national climate action through capacity-building, technical assistance and strategic networking—mobilizing know-how and resources to drive sustainable development.

UN Climate Change is the secretariat to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. Established in 1992, the Convention has near universal membership and is the parent treaty of the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement.

The main goal of the Paris Agreement is to keep global average temperature rise this century to well below 2 degrees Celsius and to drive efforts to limit the temperature increase even further to 1.5 degrees Celsius above pre-industrial levels.
