Alignment of climate mitigation and adaptation plans with national sustainable development plans

Mitigation

- 1. 120+ CDM Projects supported (2019-2020), reached out to all new prior consideration submission in the region to organize phone calls and respond to queries
- 2. Supported development of standardized Baselines for 7 countries different sectors (Mongolia, Korea, Philippines, Myanmar, Cambodia, Pakistan, Thailand); organized virtual workshop on "Standardized Baselines and Their Applications" for DNAs (with RCC Dubai), following up on requests; promotion of SBLs
- 3. RCC Bangkok supports the Asia-Pacific Issue-Based Coalition on Climate Change Mitigation and Air pollution, focusing on NDC enhancement, Carbon Markets and Coal Phase Out in Asia-Pacific. The work includes development of knowledge products, organization of regional events and establishment of country dialogues.

Adaptation

- 1. RCC Bangkok facilitates the contribution of Adaptation programme to the Asia-Pacific Issue-Based Coalition on Building Resilience, i.e. the mapping on COVID-19 activities
- 2. Deployment of communication products (articles, newsletters, etc.), announcements, stakeholder mapping in coordination with Adaptation programme

Others

1. Dec 2019 – MoU with IGES was extended to 31 Dec 2022



Support to Article 6, Adaptation, Capacity Building on Transparency, Facilitating the Mobilizing of Climate-aligned Finance

Needs-based Finance Project: The NBF project aims to facilitate access and mobilization of climate finance for the implementation of priority mitigation and adaptation projects to address the needs identified by developing countries

- **Melanesia Spearhead Group**: Technical analysis and strategy design completed, undergoing funder outreach and implementation;
- Indian Ocean Small Island Developing States: Technical analysis validated (workshop in Male March 2020), draft strategy design to be finalized;
- South East Asia: Draft technical analysis to be validated, undergoing strategy design
- Asian Least Developed Countries: Technical analysis to be validated, undergoing strategy design
- North and Central Asia: In preparation for inception

- NDC Survey 2020 for Asia Pacific and MENA region (with RCC Dubai)
- Regular meetings with **NDC Partnership** and planning joint activities for 2021 (webinars)
- Co-organized the Asian Transparency Workshop with IGES and the Ministry of the Environment, Japan 2020.
- Supported the establishment of **Regional MRV Networks** (Southeast Asia, South Asia and possibly the Pacific) in collaboration with the GSP, UNEP-DTU and other regional stakeholders.
- RCC Bangkok supports the country support to Myanmar on **institutional arrangements** for reporting under the ETF (UN-DTU/UNFCCC, initiated, ongoing)



Collaborative Instruments for Ambitious Climate Action (CIACA)

- The newly established 'National Committee on the Establishment of Carbon Market (NCEC)' in Pakistan has met to determine its work programme. CIACA local team in Pakistan is contributing through their direct involvement in the work of the Ministry for Climate Change.
- **Conducted Regional Dialogues on Carbon Pricing (REdiCAP)** for the ASEAN countries (Sept.'20) and planning the next one for Central Asia; ADB, UNEP and UNESCAP are partner in this initiative
- The CI-ACA team and Singapore finalized **ASEAN CIACA 2.0** proposal, which aims to implement actions based on the recommendations from ASEAN-CIACA Phase 1 and Phase 2 (2017-2019). The proposal was presented to the AWGCC and will be endorsed in the annual meeting in Q4/2020
