Matters relating to the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures serving the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chairs

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) convened a meeting of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures (hereinafter referred to as the forum) in accordance with decisions 7/CP.24, 3/CMP.14 and 7/CMA.1.

2. During the meeting, the SBSTA and the SBI took note of the annual report of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) for 2020-2021¹ [considered by the forum] and the technical discussions held during the informal event and technical expert meetings of the KCI in 2020 and 2021².

3. [The SBSTA and SBI invite Parties and observers to submit by (place holder for date) their views on the midterm review of the workplan of the forum and its KCI³ and request the secretariat to prepare a synthesis report based on the submissions with a view to informing Parties' discussion on the midterm review of the workplan that will take place at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (June 2022)⁴.]

[The SBSTA and SBI take note of the request of the forum to the KCI to prepare a synthesis report by February 2022, with the assistance of the secretariat, as a contribution to the global stocktake technical assessment that starts at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (June 2022)⁵

The SBSTA and the SBI, having considered the implementation of the workplan by the forum and its KCI, recommended a draft decision on this matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-sixth session, Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its sixteenth session and Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its third session.

Recalling decisions 7/CP.24, 3/CMP.14, 7/CMA.1, 4/CP.25, 4/CMP.15 and 4/CMA.2,

1. Welcomes the annual report of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) for 2020–2021^{6,7};

2. Welcomes with appreciation the informal event and technical expert meetings in 2020 and 2021⁸ organized by the Chairs of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI);

3. Welcomes the substantial progress made by the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures (hereinafter referred to as the forum) and its KCI in implementing relevant activities of the workplan of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures and its Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (hereinafter referred to as the workplan)⁹;

4. [Notes the limited progress on the implementation of certain activities of the workplan by the forum, and requests the secretariat to hold a two-day pre-session meeting in conjunction with SB 56 to further advance the implementation of activities number 1, 3, 4 and 11];

5. Notes with appreciation that the KCI agreed to approaches for mainstreaming gender into its activities, and encourages the KCI to continue its efforts in this regard and to report on this matter as requested in decision 3/CP.25;

[Requests the forum to continue considering the annual report of the KCI for 2020-2021, including the recommendations and considerations contained therein, at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies (June 2022) with a view to providing recommendations for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at their next sessions;]

6ter. [Adopts the following recommendations as forwarded by the forum pertaining to the following activities of the workplan:

(a) Activity number 1: Explore approaches to informing the development and implementation of climate change mitigation strategies, plans, policies and programmes, including nationally determined contributions and/or long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies, that maximize the positive and minimize the negative impacts of response measures;

(i) Recommendations: (copy text from KCI annual report 2020-2021, para 24);

(b) Activity number 3: Facilitate the development, enhancement, customization and use of tools and methodologies for modelling and assessing the impacts of the implementation of response measures, including identifying and reviewing existing tools and approaches in data-poor environments, in consultation with technical experts, practitioners and other relevant stakeholders;

(i) Recommendations: (copy text from KCI 5th meeting report, annex III, para 1(d) – 1(g));

(c) Activity number 4: Enhance the capacity and understanding of Parties, through collaboration and input from stakeholders, on the assessment and analysis of the impacts of the implementation of response measures to facilitate the undertaking of economic diversification and transformation and just transition;

[*Takes notes* of the forum’s request, as noted by the SBSTA and SBI at their 2021 session, that the KCI prepare a synthesis report by February 2022, with the assistance of the secretariat, as a contribution to the global stocktake technical assessment that starts at the fifty-sixth sessions of the subsidiary bodies.¹⁰]
