




HOW IS THE RPG UPDATED? RPG 2020

CONCLUSIONS

- The LRs took note of the background papers "Completeness and transparency assessment of information reported in technical review reports of 3rd biennial reports 2020 update" and "Assessment of information related to impacts of policies and measures reported in technical review reports of the third biennial reports" prepared by the secretariat and acknowledge that the analyses contained therein facilitates improvement of the review process. The LRs requested the secretariat to continue updating the analysis of consistency in review based on the technical reviews of the BR4s and present the analysis as an input for discussion during the next meeting of LRs.
- The LRs also requested the secretariat to continue collecting information on and analysing the review-related issues raised by the ERTs during BR4 reviews, with a view to presenting them for discussion at the eight meeting of LRs in 2021.



CONCLUSIONS – AFTER GROUP DISCUSSIONS

 The LRs requested the secretariat to prepare the RPG 2020 by incorporating the approaches discussed and agreed at the seventh meeting of LRs. These approaches include [cross-cutting], [policies and measures] and [projections issues]. The LRs agreed that the review approaches presented in the RPG 2020 will be applied by ERTs in the remaining reviews of BR4.
