Rafael Moser is a climate finance practitioner, with 10+ years of experience in the sector. Rafael currently works as a Programme Specialist at United Nations Capital Development Fund (UNCDF) and is based in Bangkok, Thailand, where he supports the implementation of the Local Climate Adaptive Living (LoCAL) Facility in the world's most climate vulnerable nations (least developed countries, small island developing States, and African countries) through the establishment of country-based mechanisms to channel climate finance for locally-led adaptation, using performance-based grants.

Prior to UNCDF, Rafael served as a Technical Advisor to the Montreal Protocol at UNDP, and as a researcher at the Fundação Getúlio Vargas, a leading Brazilian think tank, whereby he coordinated empirical research on the impact of climate change on microfinance institutions and their clients.

Rafael holds a Bachelor's Degree in International Studies and a Master's Degree in European and International Studies, from the University of Trento, in Italy.
