

UNFCCC Cooperative Climate Initiative Registration: Process for Re-Reviews

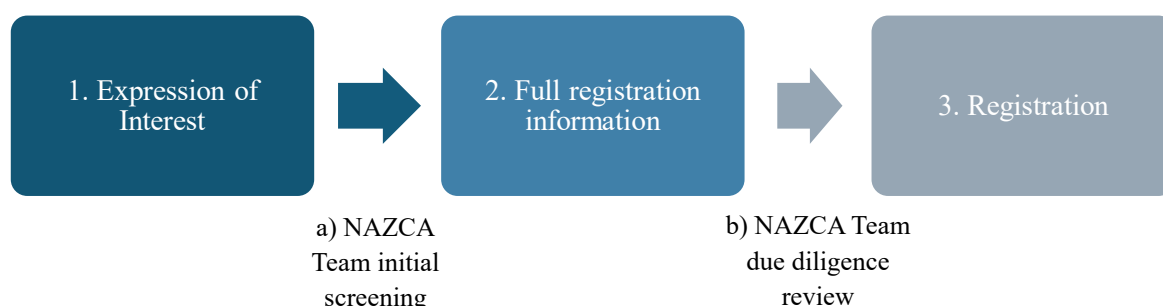
An initiative expressing interest and providing information to the UNFCCC to register itself as a NAZCA Cooperative Climate Initiative (CCI), may be deemed non-eligible. In such a case, the applicant of the initiative may request a re-review, in accordance with the procedures set out below.

I. NAZCA CCI registration process and points of review

The NAZCA team undertakes review of submitted information at two stages of the registration process:

- a) Upon receipt of an Expression of Interest (EOI) from an interested initiative; and
- b) Upon receipt of the initiative's complete registration information.

Where the outcome of both reviews is positive, the initiative will be registered as a NAZCA CCI. The standard registration process is outlined below.



II. Stages when an initiative may be deemed initially ineligible

Where an initiative is found not to meet the definition of a CCI,¹ it may be deemed ineligible either (a) at initial screening stage, or (b) at the due diligence and review stages. In such cases, the initiative shall be duly informed of the decision once it has been reached.

A. Re-Review at the initial screening stage

Should an initiative wish to request a re-review of its submission when it was deemed non-eligible at the initial screening stage, it may do so by following the steps outlined below. Such a request may be submitted by a representative of the applicant initiative, or by a person acting on the initiative's behalf.

To request a re-review, the initiative shall:

- 1) Send a request for re-review by email to NAZCA@unfccc.int. Where the request is submitted by a representative acting on the initiative's behalf, the initiative's main representative (the person who submitted the EOI) shall be copied on the correspondence;
- 2) Provide any additional information as may be requested by the NAZCA team; and

- 3) Await the outcome of the re-review, which will be communicated by the NAZCA team in due course.

B. Request of re-consideration against non-eligibility at due diligence stage

Where an applicant initiative is not approved following submission of its complete registration information, the NAZCA team will provide clarification as to the reasons for this decision. Should the initiative wish to be re-considered, the initiative shall:

1. Review the NAZCA CCI definition and eligibility criteria to ascertain whether it meets the requirements of the framework;
2. Submit a new EOI using the form;² and
3. Await review by the NAZCA team and notification of subsequent steps.
