SUMMARY OF DISCUSSIONS: NATIONAL LEVEL

- Aggregated data is one useful data still lacking in many national databases.
- Understanding climate change vs. climate finance data is still a work-in progress among nations.
- Data hosting has been a challenge since some nations do not allow their data to be hosted overseas.
- An institutionalized national communication process which integrates data gathered would serve as a vital tool in for financing institutions.
- More than the quantitative aspect of data, a qualitative one such as people's knowledge and experiences are also useful sources of information.
