He is the Director of the Climate, Environment and Sustainable Development Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Egypt. And currently he is part of the COP27 Presidency Team leading the Team on the UNFCCC Negotiations. Previously as a Desk Officer serving as Deputy Assistant Minister for Environmental Affairs and Sustainable Development covering Climate Change, Bio-fuels, Food Crises, Sustainable Development.
