Rob is the Head of Finance, Technology and Capacity Building within the UK COP 26 Presidency team and has served in a senior role for the UK delegation at a number of previous COPs. Prior to the UK Presidency, he also worked to develop the UK's International Climate Finance strategy, including plans to deliver a doubling of UK climate finance to £11.6bn and broader work to align international development finance with the Paris Agreement.

He has held a number of domestic facing climate policy roles within the UK Treasury and Department for Energy and Climate Change, including overseeing a significant uplift in low carbon innovation funding and reforms to UK power sector decarbonisation policy. He holds an MSc in Sustainability, Planning and Environmental Policy from Cardiff University.
