Thank you for giving the opportunity to submit input and we have two requests for clarifications.

In the "Procedural background" it is mentioned "For the purpose of brevity, the term "removal activities" has been used in this note to imply "activities involving removals"." *Question/clarification:* 

Many projects have both an avoided component and a removal component, like restoration of peatland and projects with a more holistic approach covering different nature types, like seagrass and salt march. Are these examples covered by "activities involving removals"?

It should be clarified which type of projects are included as "activities involving removals"

In the "4.8. Long-term carbon storage methods in removal activities" it is descripted that "when the biomass used for combustion comes from biomass waste or other sources outside of a removal activity (i.e. it was not sequestered within a removal activity), the resulting BECCS system achieves emission reductions, and not removals."

*Question/clarification:* 

Can you elaboration on what is meant by "outside of a removal activity" that is used to classify whether a biomass source is eligible for achieving removals or reductions?
