## SB58 GST TD1.3: Roundtables 1, 2 and 3. Interventions from the Farmers Constituency 13 June 2023

## **Common themes**

• • The Farmers' constituency is grateful for this opportunity to participate at GST roundtables 1, 2 and 3 not only because agriculture is on the frontline of climate impacts but because NDCs have only "somewhat increased their commitments in agriculture".

• Farmers have examples of best practices from their day-to-day and generational experiences and knowledge of working and living on the land.

• • Active engagement with farmers and farmers organisations is critical for success.

• • The GST must provide clear guidance to Parties on raising credible ambition and action for our sector, that respects human rights and the rights of farmers.

## Roundtable 1: Mitigation (including response measures)

• Agriculture is unique in being both a source and sink of GHG emissions.

• Agriculture is a major contributor of GHG emissions; however, the reality is that the same agricultural sector is a minor recipient of climate finance, with a mitigation financing gap and limited investment in research and innovation on mitigation measures for CO2 and non-CO2 emissions. If this does not change, it will not be possible to unlock the vital role of farmers in implementing low carbon farming practices for example, improving animal health, and nature-based solutions.
