

What's Already Working?

36% of Intact Forest Landscapes are within Indigenous Peoples' lands

Preventing conversion would result in:

Restoration opportunity is also huge:


6.1 Gt CO2eq per year in avoided emissions

8.7 Gt CO2eq per year in carbon sequestered by 2050.

5-10 Gt CO2eq / year additional sequestration

Indigenous and community lands across 64 countries store >293 gigatonnes of carbon.






What actions bring the greatest co-benefits?

Securing community land rights creates more resilient landscapes that directly contribute to climate change adaptation and mitigation.
