BACKGROUND

Integrated, holistic and balanced between mitigation and adaptation for NMA in the implementation of Parties NDC.

Paris Agreement Article 6.9:

Cooperation NMA to encourage ambition and to support sustainable development;

Decision 4/CMA3 para 3:

Views from Parties to add potential initial focus area;

Dec 8/CMA4 para 6 and 7:

The function of NMA Web Based Platform and Private, Observer, and Civil Society Organization may voluntary to submit lesson learn and potential proposal via NFP A6.8;

Dec 17/CMA5 para 5, 7 and 14:

Invite interest Parties to notify the secretariate of the A6.8 PA to enable them to access the UNFCCC web based platform.

Invite Parties to submit their views in related to Themes for spin-off groups and existing NMA under the initial focus area of the work program activities

Proposal Themes:

- 1. How to ensure that nonmarket approaches is carried out in accordance with the principles and framework as guided by decision 4 CMA 3 and decision 8 CMA4.
- 2. How the host country can provide recognition for non-market voluntary cooperation, by providing a certificate of appreciation that international partners have provided financial support for the host country's NDC contribution.

OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To Promote Mitigation and Adaptation
- 2. To Enhance participation of public and private sector and civil society organization in implementer's NDC
- 3. To enable opportunities for coordination across instruments and relevant institutional arrangements



PRINCIPALS:

- 1. The Framework:
 - a) To Facilitate the use and coordination of NMAs in the implementation of Parties 'NDC in the context of Sustainable Development and poverty eradication;
 - b) To enhance linkages and create synergies between, inter alia, mitigation, adaptation, finance, technology development and transfer, and capacity building, while avoiding duplication of the efforts under the framework;
- 2. NMAs facilitated under the framework represent:
 - a) Voluntary cooperative actions that are not reliant on market-based approaches and that do not include transactions or quid pro quo operations;
 - b) Integrated, innovative and transformational actions that have significant potential to deliver higher mitigation and adaptation ambition;
 - c) Actions that support the implementation of NDCs of Parties hosting NMAs (hereinafter referred to as host Parties) and contribute to achieving the long-term temperature goal of the Paris Agreement;
 - d) Does not involve the transfer of any mitigation outcomes;
