- ✓ Maintaining balance requires making progress across all agenda items.
- ✓ Resolving issues at SB 64 will contribute to Party-driven decision-making.



SB 64 items expected to result in COP 31 decisions*

- **SBSTA 8 / SBI 9:** Sharm el-Sheikh joint work on implementation of climate action on agriculture and food security (**SJWA**)
