Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism of the Convention

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), at its fifty-seventh session, considered the progress of the Technology Executive Committee, the Climate Technology Centre and Network, the Green Climate Fund and the Global Environment Facility in strengthening the linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism.

2. The SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBI 58 (June 2023) with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-eighth session (November 2023), taking into account the draft text on the UNFCCC website.¹
