## Training programme for review experts for the technical review of biennial reports and national communications of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention

## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) assessed the continued utility and implementation period of the training programme for review experts for the technical review of biennial reports and national communications of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention,<sup>1</sup> taking into account paragraphs 42 and 44 of decision 1/CP.24, the number of reviews for which reviewers might be needed after 2024 and the outcome of the deliberations of Parties on the training programme for technical experts participating in the technical expert review of biennial transparency reports under the Paris Agreement.<sup>2</sup>

2. The SBSTA agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBSTA 57 (November 2022).
