Under the work on strengthening considerations regarding vulnerable communities, groups and ecosystems (decision 6/CP.16, paragraph 2c)

- ❑ Technical session conducted at NAP Expo 2016 with the NWP partner organizations to discuss the considerations regarding vulnerable communities, groups and ecosystems
- ❑ A technical paper is being developed based on the outcomes of the sessions
- ❑ The paper will be used as part of the supplements to the guidelines for the formulation and implementation of NAPs
- ❑ Specific session was integrated in the meeting of party experts to assess progress in NAPs – one of the key observations was that consideration of trade offs would be important in managing ecosystem based adaptation solutions and community based adaptation



Organization of a session on human settlements and climate change adaptation

- ❑ Led by UNHABITAT, with the engagement of other organizations working on human settlements
- ❑ Session focused on adaptation in urban areas focusing on human settlements
- ❑ The session will inform development of a supplement to the NAP technical guidelines on human settlements and climate change adaptation



Continued engagement in training on NAPs, Open NAPs, NAP Expos, and other activities

- ❑ This year we will be working on the design training workshops on NAPs to be held in 2019
- ❑ Open NAP case studies, whereby the LEG taps on and mobilizes interested organizations to provide technical support towards developing the case studies
- ❑ We will conduct regional NAP Expos – in the pipeline we have one to be held in conjunction with the 12th International Conference on Community Based Adaptation, in June 2018, and another one in conjunction with the 3rd Inter-Ministerial Conference on Health and Environment in Africa
- ❑ NWP partner organizations are invited to share information on their NAP related events on NAP Central



Continuing engagement

- ❑ The LEG will continue to engage NWP partner organizations in implementing relevant activities as included in their two-year rolling work programme for 2018 to 2019.
