Overall objective of NMAs

- Voluntary cooperation in the implementation of NDCs to allow for higher ambition, promote sustainable development and environmental integrity
 - Promote mitigation and adaptation ambition
 - Enhance public and private sector participation
 - Enhance cooperation across instruments and relevant institutional arrangements
- General remarks;
 - Guidelines to establish safe guards for implementing NMAs
 - Inclusion does not constitute an UNFCCC approval
 - No transactions and no quid pro quo operations



Views on additional focus areas

- Prioritize progress on the initial focus areas
 - Adaptation, resilience and sustainability
 - Mitigation measures
 - Development of clean energy sources
- Caution to avoid duplication of other workstreams

 - CTCN and TEC
 - •PCCB
 - Adaptation Committee
