## The 32<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance

## 26–28 September 2023 Geneva, Switzerland

I am pleased to notify admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance (SCF) will take place from **26 to 28 September 2023** in Geneva, Switzerland. The meeting is hosted by the Government of Switzerland represented by the Federal Office for the Environment.

Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, only **two representatives per constituency** will be permitted to participate in person. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list no later than **Monday**, **14 August 2023** via <a href="mailto:cool@unfccc.int">cool@unfccc.int</a>.

All other interested observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the constituency focal points is **Friday**, **15 September 2023**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the abovementioned deadlines may not be processed. Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in the meeting will be communicated directly to the registered participants.
