Thirty-fourth Meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance

29–31 May 2024 Bonn, Germany

I am pleased to notify admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the thirty-fourth meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance (SCF) will take place from **29 to 31 May 2024** in Bonn, Germany. On 30 May 2024, the SCF will convene a session with technical experts to advance preparations of its technical reports.

The provisional agenda for SCF 34 and the technical expert meeting, webcast link and any additional documents will be uploaded to the <u>SCF documents web page</u> prior to the meeting.

Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, **two representatives per constituency** will be permitted to participate in person. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list no later than **10 May 2024** via cool@unfccc.int.

Additional observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the constituency focal points is **15 May 2024**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadlines may not be processed. Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in the meeting will be communicated directly to the registered participants.
