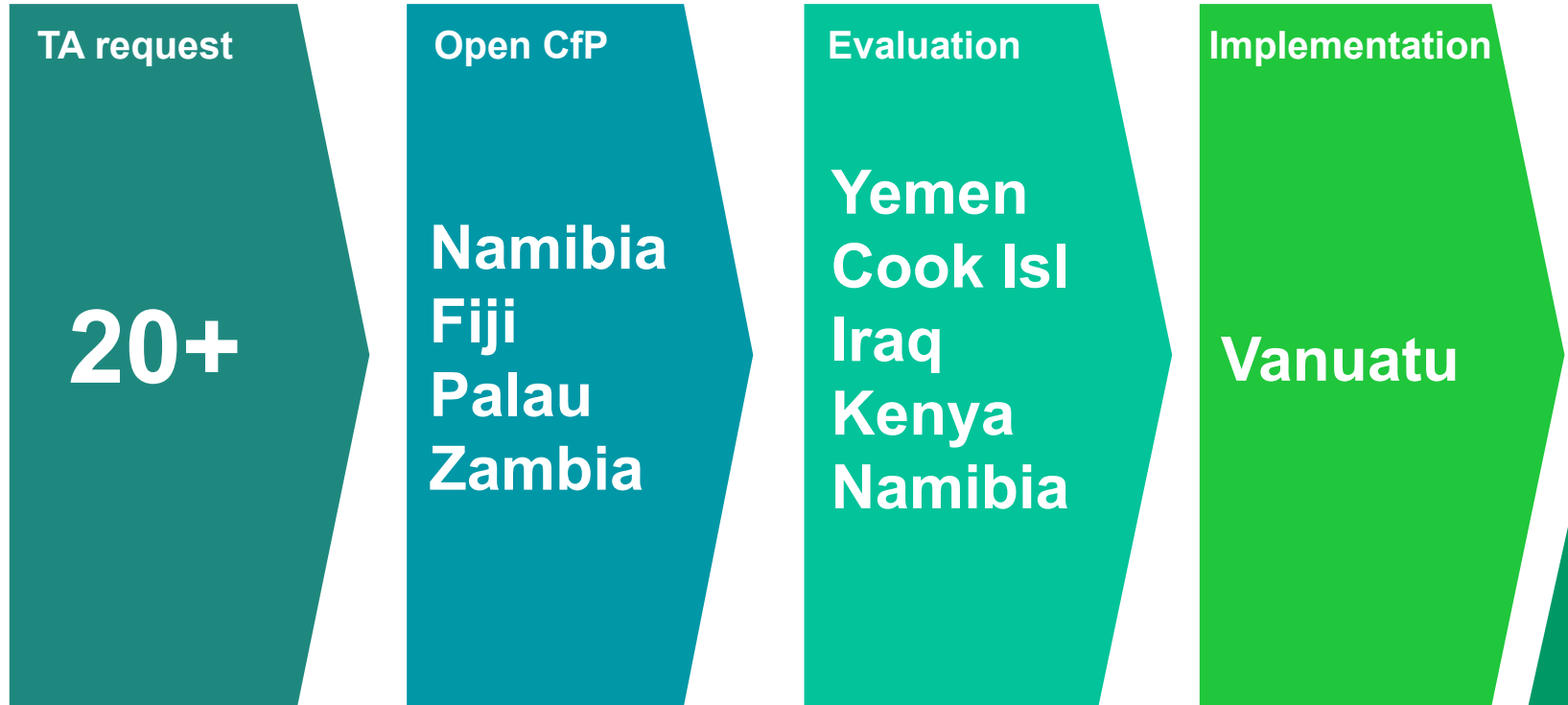

Membership composition

TOTAL MEMBERS	ORGANIZATIONS	BODIES	NETWORKS	EXPERTS
129	82	3	10	34

- **Diversity: geographic, thematic, type of OBNE**
- **17 also EG members**
 - 7 CRM, 5 NEL, 3 ASEG, 2 TFD + 4 Observers, 1 co-host
 - 13 access entities (GCF, AF, GEF)

TA pipeline drives membership

1. New TAs lead to uptick in registrations and EOIs by OBNEs

- New OBNEs submit majority of proposal
- OBNEs with local presence
 - i. Yemen: 20 EOIs
 - ii. Iraq: 23 EOIs
 - iii. Kenya: 19 EOIs

2. Strengthening engagement of OBNEs on TA requests

- Matchmaking sessions and tools

ToR for a regular report on loss and damage

1. Para 20–23 of COP30/CMA7 decision on the WIM review

- Regular, multi-year
- SNAB to prepare by its 7 meeting
- Consultation with ExCom

2. Further decisions at SNAB6 (March 26)

- Roadmap for ToR development
- Set up of drafting group

Timeline/ToRa

Date	Milestone	Key input/action
March 24-26	SNAB6 decision	Establishment of a small drafting group under the SNAB. Request the drafting group , supported by the Secretariat , to develop a zero draft for SNAB written comments within a set period.
April	Drafting group develops Draft 0	Drafting Group develops Draft 0 taking into consideration SNAB and ExCom feedback during the SNAB6 informal meeting.
April - May	SNAB inputs	SNAB review and feedback on Draft 0 during a two-week period.
April	ExCom Meeting	ExCom considers further inputs to the SNAB
May	Drafting group develops Draft 1.0	Written inputs on Draft 0 from SNAB and from ExCom meeting. Outcome: Draft 1.0 to be shared with SNAB and ExCom two weeks in advance of the structured consultation.

Timeline/ToRb

Date	Milestone	Key input/action
June 8-18	June Climate Meetings (SB64)	Structured consultation (hybrid) between SNAB and ExCom based on Draft 1.0. The consultation may include engagement with its relevant expert groups, pending confirmation by the ExCom.
July	Drafting group develops Draft 2.0 .	Drafting group develops Draft 2.0 taking into consideration SNAB and WIM Executive Committee feedback during the structured consultation in the margins of SB64.
August	SNAB informal meeting	Drafting group presents Draft 2.0 for SNAB feedback.
August-September	Drafting group develops Final draft	Final draft developed taking into consideration SNAB inputs during the informal meeting.
September	SNAB7 publication	Publication of Final draft TORs for SNAB7.
September	SNAB7 meeting	Adoption of TORs at SNAB7.

ToR development: progress so far

1. Drafting group established

- First meeting

2. First version of the draft 0 completed

- Includes Annexes (criteria for evaluation, proposal template)
- Finalisation of review
- Submission after the meeting

3. SNAB and Excom review window


- Aligned 2-week review period
- New draft by May
