Sangji Lee is a global technical specialist on NDCs, Just Transition, and Green Economy with UNDP's Climate Promise team which supports more than 120 countries in the formulation and implementation of their climate pledges under the Paris Agreement. Within the team, she spearheads UNDP's thought leadership and country support for integrating just transition into short term and long-term climate pledges and authored major knowledge products such as the UNDP's flagship publication on just transition.

Her work lies at the intersection of climate policy, development, and social equity, as she navigates the complex landscape of these domains. Sangji aids countries in understanding the developmental and social co-benefits of climate action by leveraging analytic frameworks and tools. Previously, she worked with UNDP Mozambique, the UNDP Global Policy Centre in Seoul, the OHCHR Regional Office in Fiji, the UN Department of Political Affairs, various research institutes, and government entities. As a Chevening Scholar, she earned a Master of Science degree in Environment and Development from the London School of Economics.
