Nick Robins Professor in Practice – Sustainable Finance London School of Economics and Political Science / Grantham Research Institute on Climate Change and the Environment

Nick Robins joined the Grantham Research Institute in February 2018 as Professor in Practice for Sustainable Finance. Nick leads the sustainable finance research theme. The focus of his work is on how to mobilise finance for climate action in ways that support a just transition, promoting the role of central banks and regulators in achieving sustainable development and investigating how the financial system can support the restoration of nature.

Nick is author of The Road to Net Zero Finance for the UK's Climate Change Committee and co-founder of the Financing the Just Transition Alliance and is also a Commissioner on Scotland's Just Transition Commission. He leads the finance platform for the Place-based Climate Action Network, and is co-chair of the International Network for Sustainable Finance Policy Insights, Research and Exchange (INSPIRE).

From 2014 to 2018, Nick was co-director of UN Environment's Inquiry into a Sustainable Finance System. Before joining UNEP, he was Head of the Climate Change Centre of Excellence at HSBC. He has a BA in History from Cambridge University and an MSc in International Relations from LSE.
