Second Information Note by the President on the mode of work

Additional information on the organization of work in the second week

- As announced by the President at the COP plenary on Saturday 8 December and further to additional information provided at the Heads of Delegation meeting this morning at 10:00, the President will convene a stocktaking meeting on decisions 1/CP.24 and 3/CMA.1 on **Tuesday 11 December at 17:00** in **Plenary Śląsk**.
- The deadline to conclude negotiations on the outstanding issues, to facilitate the development of new iteration of texts with clear options for consideration by Ministers, is therefore 17:00 on Tuesday 11 December.
- The Presidency has provided guidance to the lead experts and requested that they include in their consultations, interlinkages within and across topics as relevant.
- Parties are strongly encouraged to engage in more solution-oriented discussion and find landing zones rather than restating known positions.
- Work on Monday and Tuesday will continue to utilise the multi-layered approach by which some consultations, namely finance, are done at the ministerial level and others are conducted by leading experts.
- As of Wednesday 12 December, outstanding issues will be addressed through Presidency consultations at ministerial level.
