## Second rolling plan of action of the expert group on slow onset events, for 2024–2026

1. The table below sets out the second plan of action of the expert group on slow onset events, for 2024–2026, which identifies activities that will contribute to the implementation of workstream (a) of the five-year rolling workplan<sup>1</sup> of the WIM Executive Committee, related to slow onset events, including by maximizing synergies among relevant stakeholders and processes.

2. The second phase continues the following overarching approach from the first phase of its rolling plan of action.

3. Recognizing the far-reaching impacts of slow onset events on livelihoods and economies, which can manifest simultaneously in different territories and landscapes, the expert group on slow onset events will continue the work on selected water-related slow onset events (glacial retreat, sea level rise, and desertification) undertaken during the first rolling plan of action. In doing so, related processes such as salinization and cascading effects that impact, for example, agricultural practice and lead to issues such as loss of biodiversity, land degradation, water scarcity in urban and other contexts, and human mobility will be taken into account.

4. The initial aim of the second phase of the plan of action is to produce three technical guides associated with the selected water-related slow onset events to support developing countries that are particularly vulnerable to the adverse effects of climate change. The guides will present approaches for responding to these events in a timely manner, taking into account regional particularities, traditional knowledge and local practices.

5. The expert group will review the progress in implementing its rolling plan of action at its regular meetings and update the plan of action as needed.
