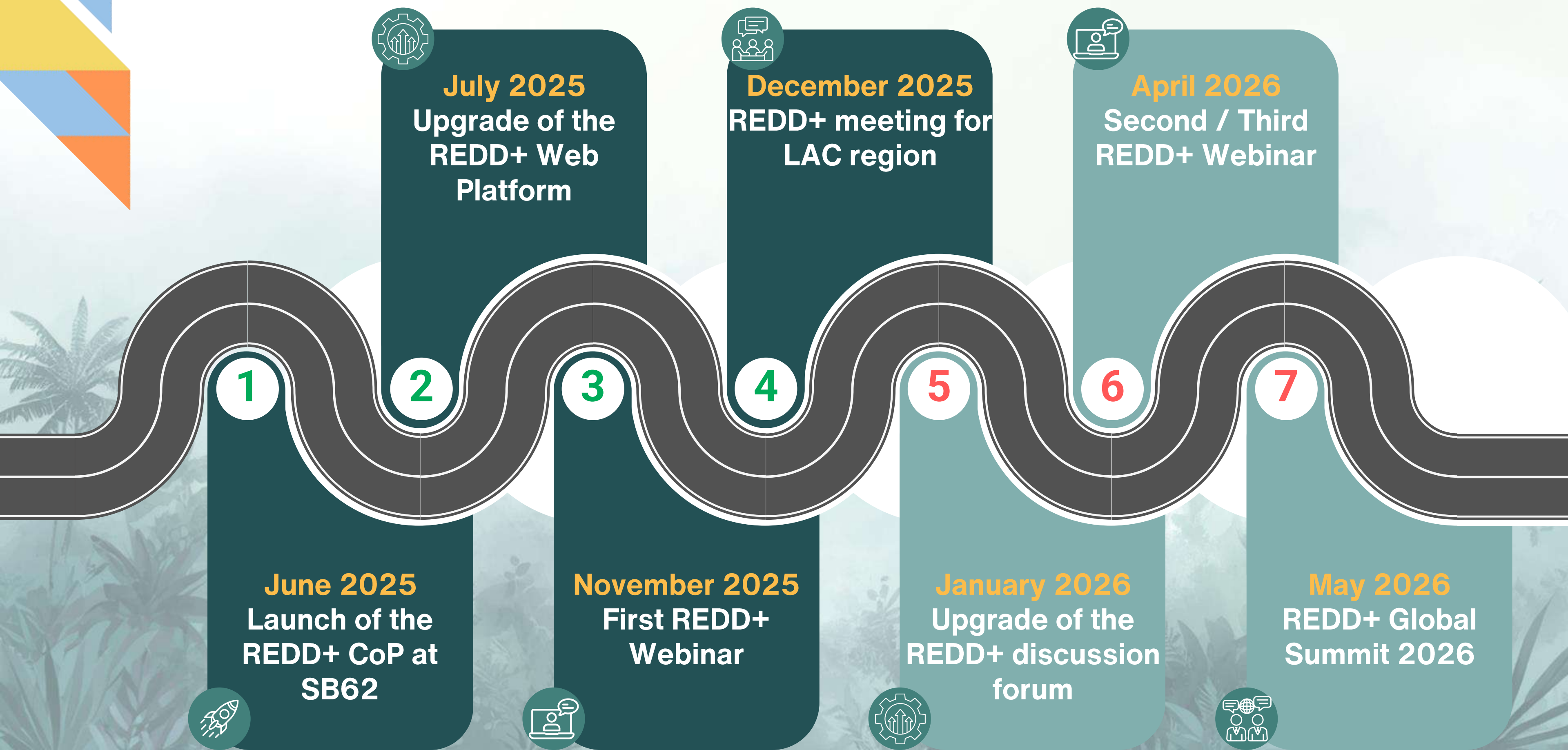

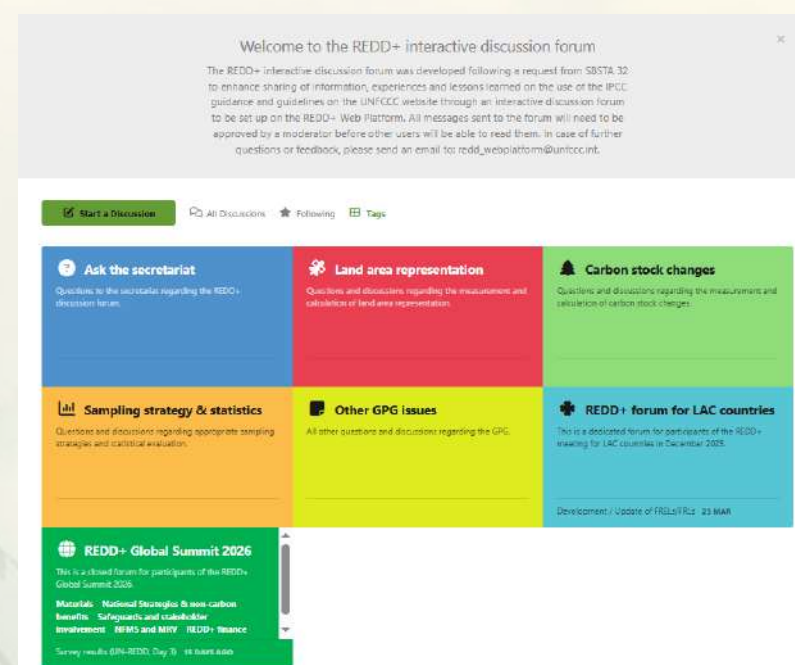

# Upgrades of the REDD+ Discussion Forum

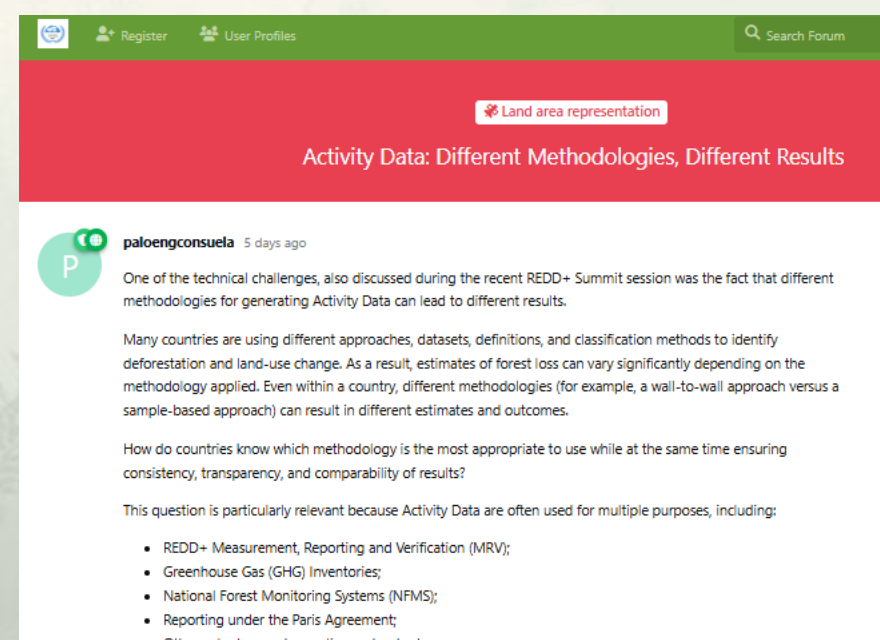
The REDD+ interactive discussion forum was developed to enhance sharing of information, experiences and lessons learned.

## Discussion function

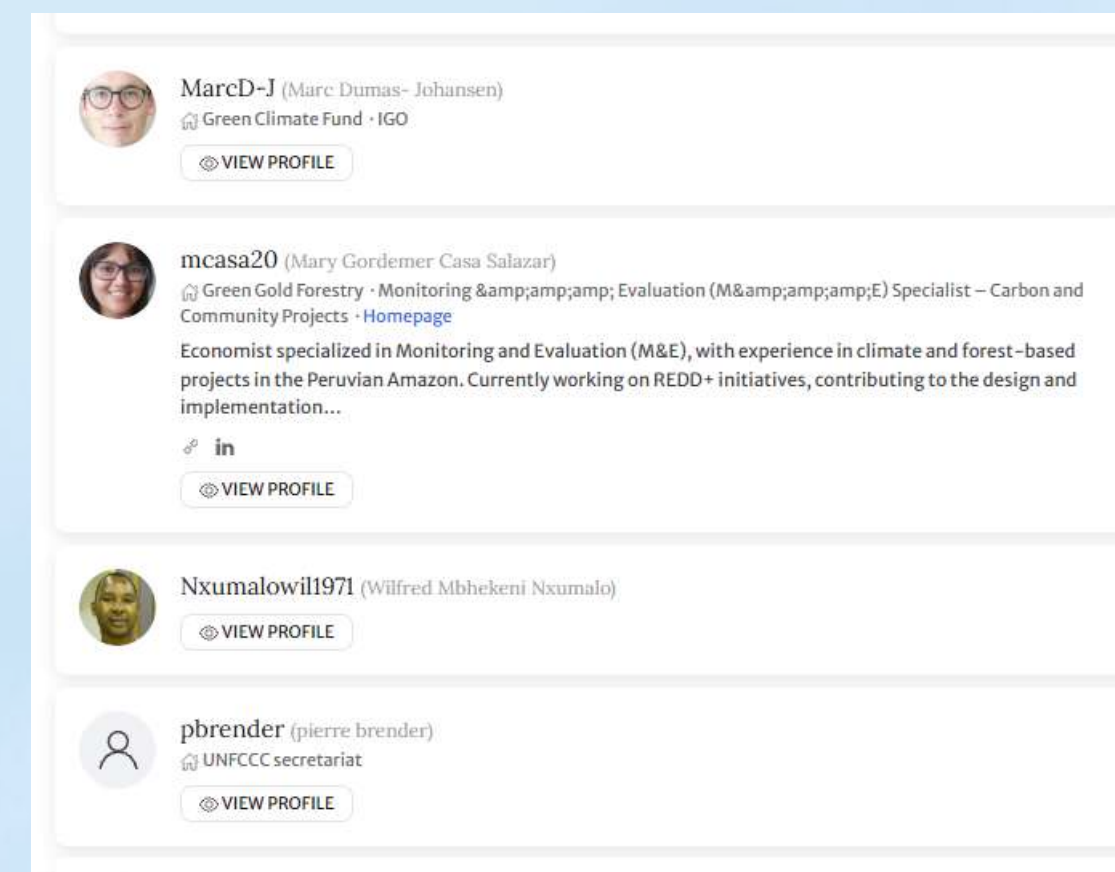


A modernized design with improved navigation and usability.

### THE REDD+ COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE: A GLOBAL MUTIRÃO FOR FORESTS

>>> **REDD+ SIDE EVENT**

At COP30, the REDD+ team organized a side event *"The REDD+ Community of Practice: A Global Mutirão for Forests"*. This event brought together experts and country representatives to reflect on how REDD+ implementation is evolving under the Paris Agreement. Speakers also presented the linkages between REDD+ and Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, new GCF results-based payments, and key insights from UNEP's State of Finance for Forests 2025 report.
