- The participating Parties involved and authorized entities;

Cooperative Approach - Agreement	Cooperative Approach – Mitigation Activity
General description of the agreement	Description of an activity
Agreement duration	Activity duration / crediting period
Expected mitigation at agreement level, each year	Expected mitigation per year

## SCE 1 Cooperative Approach Agreement

1. Authorization with signature
  2. Duration of the cooperative approach and expected mitigation
  3. Description of the cooperative approach, we believe each country to define procedures and standards:
    - Scope of cooperation
    - Governance structure (including review mechanisms)
    - Parties and their roles and responsibilities (such as DNA and focal points)
    - Environmental integrity principles and criteria
    - Processes (e.g. registration, MRV, issuance, transfer, corresponding adjustment, reporting)
    - Letter of Pre-Authorisation/Authorisation of ITMOs
    - Fees and costs
    - Reporting
    - Dispute resolution

## SCE 2 Cooperative Approach Mitigation activity

1. Date of authorization
  2. Duration of the cooperative approach and expected mitigation
  3. First transfer definition
  4. Unique identifier
  5. Participating parties
  6. Methodology information (including reversals, leakages, monitoring, additionality)
  7. Metrics

## ITMO Authorization

1. Unique identifier of the cooperative approach
2. Content of the statement/letter of authorization
  - Date of authorization
  - Information on first transferring Party
  - Standard or entity that issues the ITMOS
  - Information on the cooperative approach where the ITMOS come from
  - Information on the origin (activity, sector, geographical location, methodology used to calculate the baseline, etc.) and the information on the use if it is certain about it
  - information on activity participants authorized for the DNA of the Host Party
  - information of the acquiring Party and public and private entities that the acquiring Party authorize as activity participants.
  - In case of other international mitigation purposes, the Party shall inform:
    - the definition of ITMO that applies to it, in accordance with paragraph 2 b) of the annex of the Decision 2/CMA.3;
    - The specification of the international mitigation purpose;
    - The name of the entity that is going to use the emissions reductions transferred;
  - The number of ITMOS that are authorized.
  - Information on the unique identifier of the authorized ITMOS.
  - Metrics of authorized ITMOS.
  - Period of accreditation of the Article 6 activity.
3. Included in the parties agreement
4. Changes in authorization
