## Elements of the regional climate finance strategy

- 1. What will be the main aim (goal, objective) of the strategy?
  - a) What will be the key principles of the strategy?
  - SADC climate finance mobilization strategy-Be a regional instruments for mobilizing and accessing climate finance for the regions
  - SADC resource mobilization strategy
  - Scale that the strategy would want to influence national action
  - Avoid duplication and promote alignment
  - Addressing transboundry, needs, opportunities
  - Address common challenges (capacity building)
  - Explore Synergies with other developmental activities
  - Promote transparency and accountability
  - Established within the principle of SADC principle/alignment with the overarching SADC principle





## Elements of the regional climate finance strategy

- 1. What will be the main aim (goal, objective) of the strategy?
  - a) Objectives and goals-enhancing mobilizing of CF in the region
  - enabling climate finance resources mobilization at the regional level
  - enhance capacity of countries to mobilize CF resources at national level
  - a) What will be the scope of the strategy? (sectors, policies, financial instruments, provider types)
  - Cover regional and national issues
  - Priorities sectors mentioned in the NDC
  - Goes beyond scope of NDCs e.g National plans, strategies
  - a) What will be the timeframe of the strategy? (duration of strategy, timeframe of development)
  - Long term strategy aligned to NDC (2030) with a 5 years reviews
  - Time frame for development: 2020 and if not possible after 2021 (subject to available resources)





## Elements of the regional climate finance strategy

How can national and regional strategies and priorities be integrated into the strategy?

- MS to agree on regional priorities, policies
- Align with regional development agenda, SADC climate change strategy

Should the strategy include regional priority projects/initiatives/programmes? Yes, MS to agree on regional priorities

Will there be indicators/a process to monitor progress and assess results? Yes, align with the draft tool on MRV

How to ensure the implementation of the strategy?

- Ministers of environment will endorse the strategy, align to national processes
- Strategy should ensure enabling environment for enhancing partnerships between regional DFIs, national development banks, commercial banks
- Periodic reporting of the implementation
- SADC to be accredited with GCF to ensure operationalization of SADC programs
- Close collaboration between SADC, DBSA, AFDB resourced via e.g. Readiness finance for SADC, NDC
