- 25 African Countries receiving support to develop NAPs,
  - 21 receiving support to access GCF and LDCF finance for NAP development (5 GCF and 3 LDCF projects approved)
  - Further 4 countries receiving support to integrate agriculture into NAPs

#### **Acceleration:**

Programming – actively supporting climate mitigation and adaptation initiatives throughout the continent:

#### Adaptation Finance in Africa:

- \$ 445 million secured and under implementation in 40 Countries
- 55.3 million beneficiaries (43% women)
- 111km of coastline protected
- 55,550+ ha of agricultural land under improved agricultural practices
- 1.6 million people across 746 communities adopting more resilient agricultural practices

#### Mitigation Finance in Africa:

- \$ 208 million secured and under implementation in 34 countries
- 22 countries adopting affordable, reliable, sustainable, modern energy solutions



Mainstreaming adaptation through National Adaptation Plans







#### **CLIMATE FINANCE KEY MESSAGES**



- > Strategic Approach to Climate Finance
  - Climate Finance is part of Development Finance
  - Align climate finance with "SDGized" NDP [DFA, Africa Finance Hub],
  - Inclusive Climate Budgeting (CPEIR, CCFF working with PFM specialists)
  - GCF country programme (e.g. Vanuatu, prioritized pipeline –better chances of RM)
- Linkage of plans financing, reporting (NDCs, NAPs NCs, BUR/BTRs)
- ➤ Related Capacities: Capacity to prioritize and **plan** for, **access**, **deliver**, (Comoros 42M GCF delivery), **monitor and report** [demonstrate results and impact]
- > Related Reforms (policy, institutional, legal/regulatory) for efficiency, effectiveness, de-risking, transformative/scaled-up)
- > Transparency and accountability demand side [parliament, auditor-general, civil society]
- ➤ Central role of Ministries of Finance/Planning Coalition of Finance Ministers for Climate Action
