Strategy development – Goal



To facilitate and improve greater access and mobilization of the climate finance with SADC Member States that will allow for timely, predictable financial flows



Strategy development – Objective



1. *Enabling climate finance resource mobilization at the 1. regional level 2. multi-country level and 3. individual country level.*
2. *Facilitate regional cooperation in the form of peer-to-peer learning*

Strategy development – Expected Impacts



- *Effectiveness through transformative, impact projects*
- *Reduction in vulnerability, Reduction of GHG emissions*
- *Improved institutional capacity*

Strategy development – Strategic areas and actions



- *High level endorsement from national government (proposed level: Ministerial Level) (**Environment or Finance**)*
- *Need for a coordination entity to ensure implementation (SADC)*
- *Role of UNFCCC in facilitating partnership building*
- ***Member States need to agree on regional priorities (as per SADC regional CC project pipeline vs. Determined from a national priorities which are assessed for regional linkage)***
- *Alignment and harmonization of regional development and SADC climate change strategy as well as national CC policies*
- *Transparency/MRV – Periodic reporting of Implementation*
- *Regional Financial Instruments (Grants, Loans, Guarantees, Regional Climate Risk Management)*
- *Regional Green Bank*
- *SADC GCF Accreditation*
- *Close collaboration with SADC, DBSA, AFDB*
