



Stefan Ruchti studied forestry and environmental science in Switzerland and the US: For 30 years, he held various positions within the Swiss Federal Office for the Environment, the Swiss Federal Office of Energy, and the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs. In the latter, Stefan was Head of the Environment Unit, equally covering climate, and later on also energy and health, from 2007 to 2021. Stefan joined the International Cryosphere Climate Initiative ICCI in 2022, where he continues to actively follow the international climate negotiations. The changes in the Cryosphere being extremely worrying, including recent glacier loss and thawing of the Antarctica and Greenland ice sheets, Stefan greatly values the science – policy nexus and its interface to drive ambitious climate action.
