Dr. Stephen Hammer

Advisor, Global Climate Policy and Strategy Climate Change Group, World Bank



Dr. Stephen Hammer serves as an Advisor, focused on International Climate Policy and Strategy, with the World Bank's Climate Change Group. He represents the World Bank on numerous global commissions and working groups focused on climate finance and other topics. He previously served as Manager, Climate Policy for the World Bank Group, where he led an interdisciplinary team of 60 scientists, economists, technical experts, and consultants focused on frontier research on climate change and development topics, the mainstreaming of climate change in World Bank operations, and the provision of climate-related advisory services to clients and Bank teams.

Before joining the World Bank, Dr. Hammer was a Professor of Energy Planning at MIT's Department of Urban Studies and Planning (DUSP), and prior to that, he taught at Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs, where he founded and directed the Urban Energy Program. Dr. Hammer holds a PhD from the London School of Economics, an MPP from the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University, and a B.S. from the University of California at Davis.
