

## Decision X/CMA.3

### **Compilation and synthesis of, and summary report on the in-session workshops on, biennial communications of information related to Article 9.5 of the Paris Agreement**

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement

Recalling Decision 12/CMA.1,

Also recalling Article 9, paragraphs 1–5, of the Paris Agreement,

Further recalling Articles 3, 4, 7, 10, 11 and 14 of the Paris Agreement,

- 1) Welcomes the biennial submissions on indicative quantitative and qualitative information related to Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement received from developed country Parties in accordance with decision 12/CMA.1 and urges developed country Parties who have not provided a submission to do so as soon as possible;
- 2) Welcomes the summary report on the in-session workshop and the compilation and synthesis report prepared by the secretariat;
- 3) Takes note of the report on the determination of needs and the synthesis report on the nationally determined contributions and adaptation communications submitted by developing country Parties,
- 4) Urges developed countries to increase the ambition for the provision of support for developing countries in their next biennial communications of support
- 5) Requests developed country Parties to continue to improve the quality and granularity of information provided, in accordance to the Annex of Decision 12/CMA.1, and to further provide information on:
  - a) How the need for public grant based resources for adaptation is taken into account, in line with article 9.4 of the Paris Agreement
  - b) how projected levels of resources are aligned with the commitment to jointly mobilize 100bn a year as of 2020
  - c) information on the types of financial instruments that will be used to mobilize and provide resources and how they align to the needs and priorities of developing countries
  - d) how channels that will be used to mobilize and provide resources, including through the operating entities of the financial mechanism of the Convention and the Adaptation Fund
  - e) how the projected level of resources promote a balance between adaptation and mitigation.

- f) how developed countries plan to support developing countries implementation of Article 2.1 c
  - g) The criteria for evaluation of proposals by public sources and bilateral agencies
  - h) Additional information beyond bilateral contributions and contributions to the GCF and GEF
  - i) Clarifications over the definition of financial support as being new and additional
  - j) The distinction between ex post information in Biennial Reports and future Biennial Transparency Reports and ex ante information in biennial communications in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement
- 6) Invites developed country Parties to take into account the areas of improvement identified in the report of the biennial in-session workshop on information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement, in their next round of submissions.
- 7) Requests the secretariat to consider the elements presented in para 5 as possible guiding topics for discussion in the next biennial in-session workshops.
- 8) Urges the developed country Parties to ensure compliance to their responsibilities towards the Paris Agreement.
