

Inputs by Non-Party Stakeholders – Global Stocktake – 8/9 June 2021

Statement by Switzerland

Thank you, Co-Facilitator, and hello colleagues,

Switzerland has already stressed yesterday, how important it is to consider and include inputs from civil society and non-Party stakeholders, including Youth, in the Global Stocktake.

Non-Party stakeholders, and civil society in general, have a very important role in climate action. Their shared knowledge and insights also are most valuable in the assessment and guidance of Parties' efforts.

Accordingly, their views and insights are equally most valuable for the Global Stocktake.

Switzerland would like to hear from the Secretariat, how – based on their wealth of experience in these matters – inputs from admitted observers and non-Party stakeholders in general, are best shared and considered.

We would also like to hear from admitted observers and non-Party stakeholders in general, how, and by what means, they view their inputs best taken into account.

Key would be to have an efficient system that would provide a wealth of input, and at the same time not overburden any of the participants in the Global Stocktake, and neither the Secretariat.
