Omar Al Braiki currently serves as the Deputy Climate Chief Negotiator at the office of the UAE special envoy for climate change. His primary responsibility at the office is ensuring the presidency plays an active role in driving implementation of the UAE Consensus delivered at COP28.

Throughout Omar's career, he has been actively engaged in the environment, climate, renewables, sustainability, and diplomacy sectors, where he plays an active role in multiple technical Committees, boards, and fellowships, which include the UAE National Climate Council, the UAE UN Delegates Council, Environmental enforcement, and the permitting and compliance technical committee, as well he has served as member of the board of trustees for the Anwar Gargash Diplomatic Academy.

Along with his primary responsibilities, he also serves as a climate fellow at the Jackson School of Global Affairs at Yale and as a fellow at the UAE National Experts Program, where he advises on UAE renewables and sustainability policy. Omar has been received multiple recognitions for his work in the sector, most notably the first class order of Zayed II medal from His Highness Sheikh Mohamed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE.
