has also served as a Lead Negotiator on Climate Finance for AOSIS, SIDS Board Member of the Adaptation Fund, Advisor to the SIDS Board Seat of the Green Climate Fund, an Alternate Member for the Latin America and Caribbean region on the Paris Agreement Implementation and Compliance Committee, as well as SIDS Advisor and Member of the UNFCCC's Transitional Committee for the Loss and Damage Fund and Funding Arrangements.

He holds a Master of Laws (LLM) in Environmental Law and Policy from University College London, and a Bachelor of Laws (LLB) from Oxford Brookes University.
