Prior to joining WRI, she oversaw the environmental affairs at Peru's Ministry of Economy and Finance, where she managed the role of MEF as national designated authority (NDA) to the GCF, led the development of the first Monitoring, Reporting and Verification system to identify climate finance expenditure, drafted and assessed legal frameworks and national projects regarding environmental policies and international treaties, such as the first Peruvian climate change law and regulation and the

OECD Economy and Environment Chapter of Peru's Environmental Performance Review, and represented the Ministry as a national delegate for the UN climate negotiations.

She holds a master's degree in environmental policy and law from Stanford University and a bachelor's degree from Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú (PUCP).
