

TASK FORCE ON DISPLACEMENT

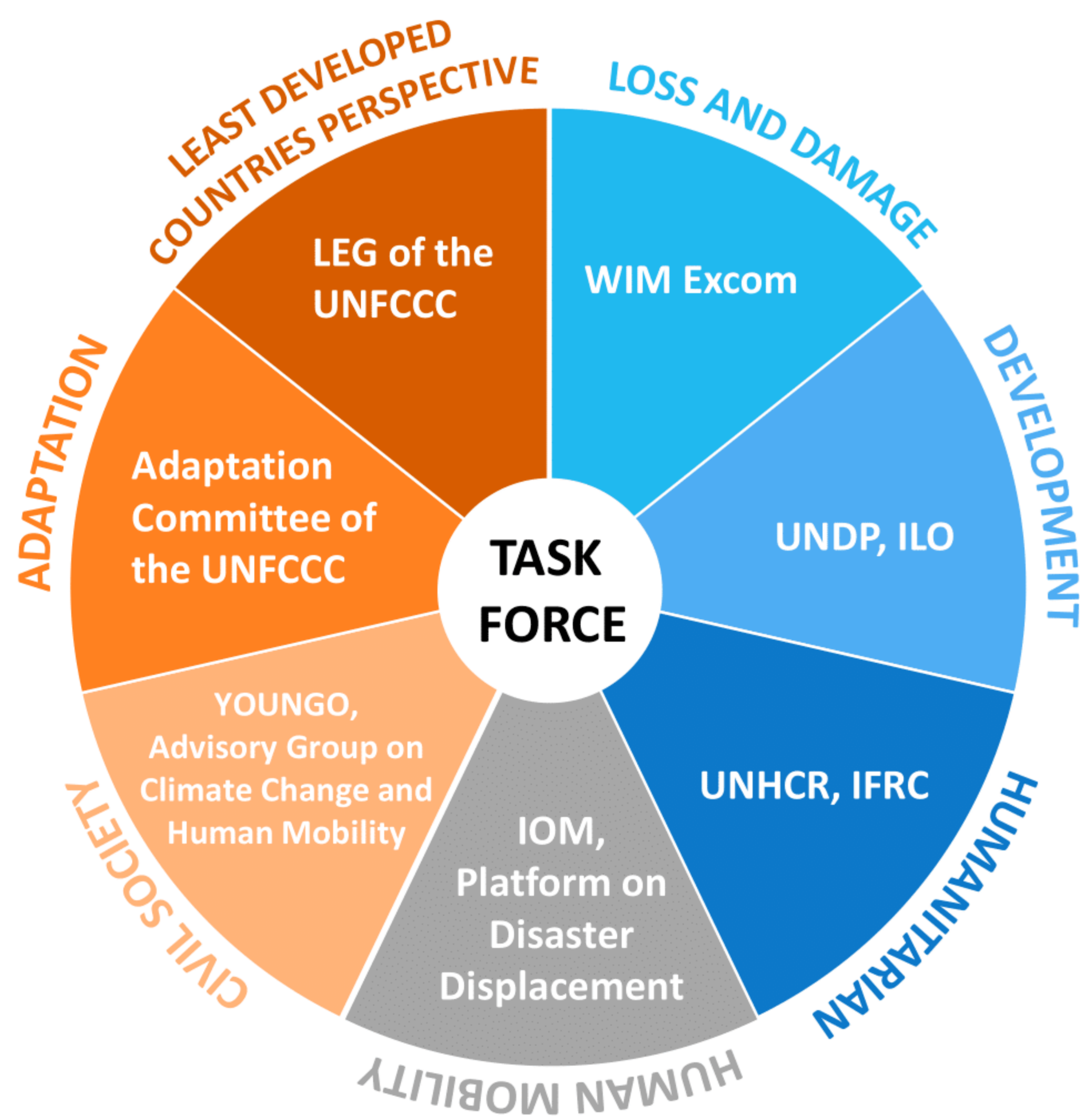
The Conference of the Parties, at its 21st session in Paris, created a Task Force to develop recommendations for integrated approaches to avert, minimize and address displacement related to the adverse impacts of climate change.

The Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage (Excom) is entrusted by the COP to operationalize this Task Force on Displacement.

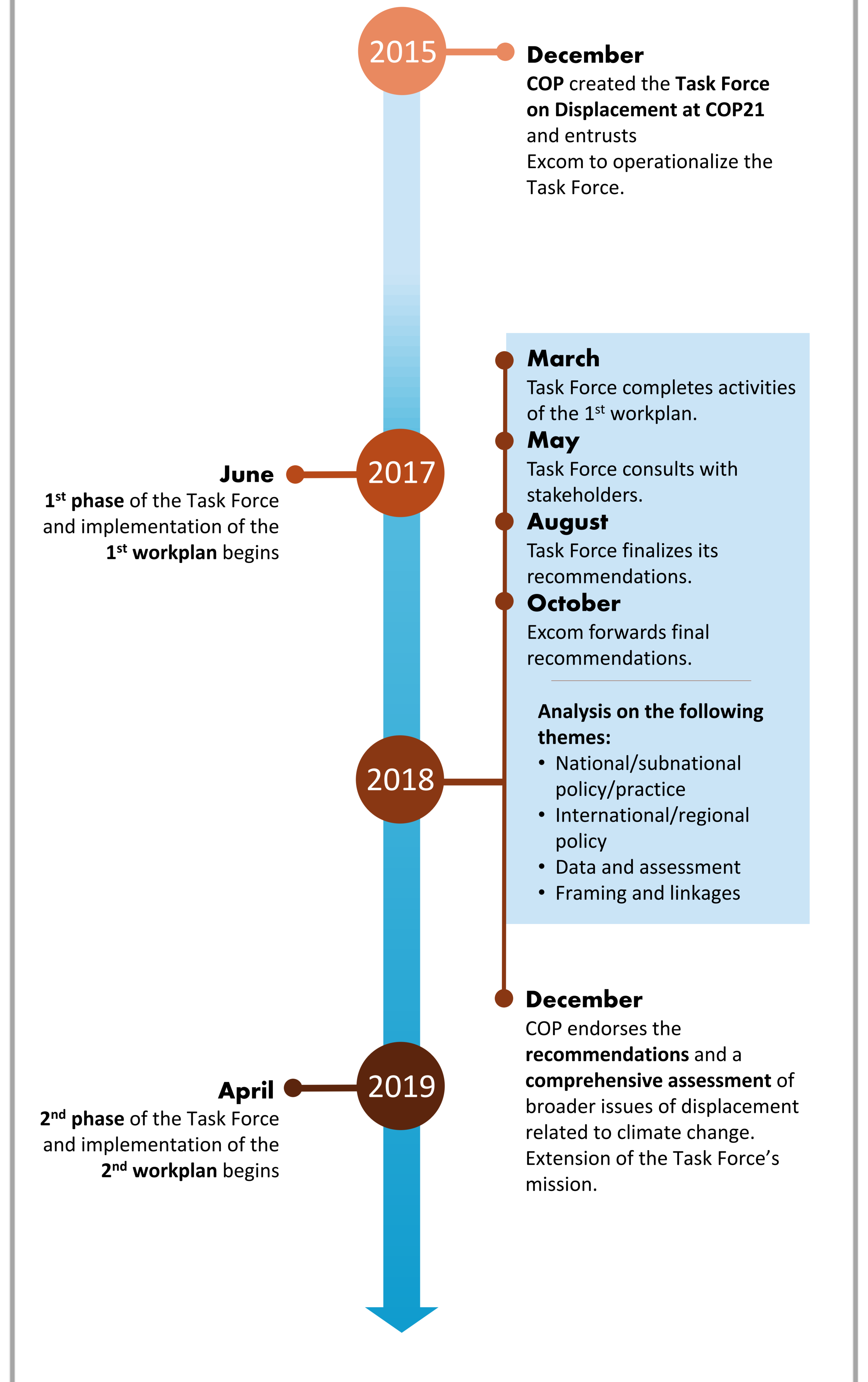
