At the High-Level Segment of the 30th Session of the Conference
of the Parties to the UNFCCC (COP30)
18 November 2025, Plenary Amazonas
Belém, Federative Republic of Brazil

Mr. President,
Excellencies,
Distinguished Delegates,

First, Thailand would like to extend our gratitude to the government of Brazil for hosting COP 30 in Belém, the heart of the Amazon. We believe COP 30 will reaffirm our collective solidarity and our unwavering commitment to advancing global climate negotiations and fostering enhanced climate action at all levels in response to the escalating climate crisis.

Mr. President,

Thailand arrives at COP 30 with a bold ambition by 2035. Under the new NDC 3.0, we set an absolute emission reduction target of 47% below the 2019 level, resulting in a net country emission of 152 million tons of Carbon dioxide equivalent. This move aligns with the 1.5-degree pathway, accelerating our Net-Zero Emissions target to 2050.

As a country highly vulnerable to climate impacts, Thailand emphasizes the importance of measurable outcomes of the Global Goal on Adaptation. We stand ready to work with all Parties for ensuring that the GGA indicators are coherent between global progress and national implementation.

Mr. President,

In parallel, Thailand has put in place a robust, transparent, and credible national system in implementing Article 6. We achieved real emission reductions, shared benefits, and built a reliable and sustainable carbon market that supports both global goals and domestic actions.

Another key milestone is the forthcoming Climate Change Act which will serve as a foundation for a long-term, whole-of-society approach to climate action by establishing National Climate Fund and Carbon Pricing Instruments.

In September this year, we organized the fourth Thailand Climate Action Conference under the theme “Inspiring Climate Solutions for All” which attracted over 11,000 participants, including representatives from more than 30 embassies, reflecting strong international and cross-sectoral collaboration in Thailand.

Mr. President,

COP 30 is a pivotal moment to reaffirm our unity and determination. Let us ensure that the outcomes from Belém foster trust, accelerate implementation, and deliver tangible progress for our planet. Together, we can make this Decade of Implementation truly a Decade of Transformation. In the spirit of the Global Mutirão (มู-ฉี-ราว), Thailand stands ready to join hands with all partners to drive faster climate action.
