- **explore synergies with other national processes, strive towards implementation of NDCs**

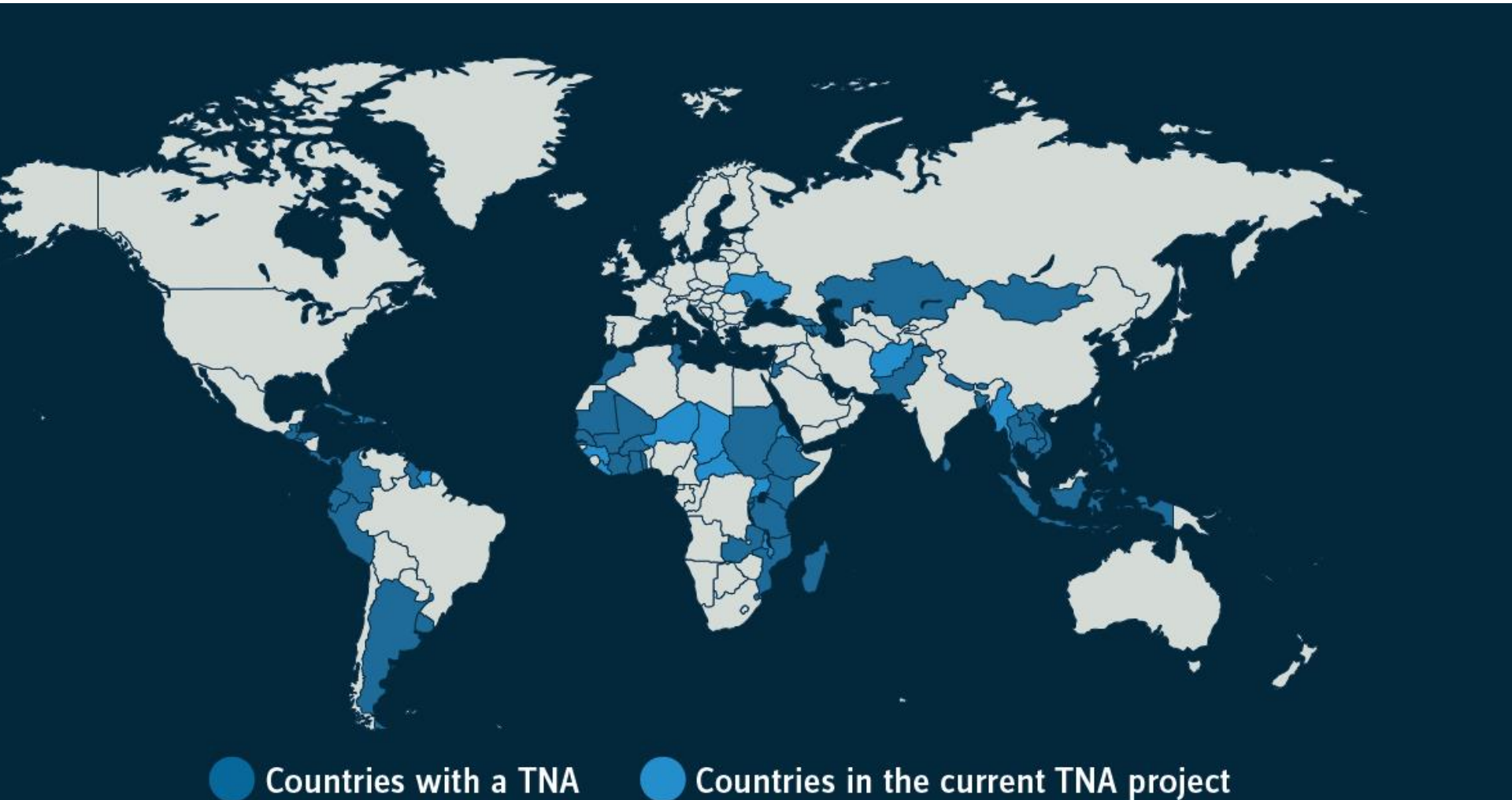
