Thelma is a Brazilian mathematician, teacher and researcher working in the area of climate change. She received her bachelor's and master's degrees from Roosevelt University, in the United States, and completed her doctorate in spatial statistics from the University of Sheffield, in England. She is a retired researcher at Inpe (National Institute for Space Research) and from 2015 to 2023 she was vice-president of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change.

Since October 2023, Dr Thelma Krug is the Chair of the Global Climate Observing System (GCOS) Steering Committee and member of the WMO Infrastructure Commission Management Group.
