Ms. Wollansky has been working on different aspects of climate change policy for almost 30 years. Since the early 1990s, she has been dealing with legal aspects of the EU emissions trading and the implementation of the system. Since 2012, she has been working on international climate finance and the project portfolio of the ministry. Ms Wollansky has represented Austria in EU committees and expert groups dealing with climate issues; currently, she is co-coordinator of the EU group of finance experts. She attended many UNFCCC meetings as a member of the Austrian delegation since 1992. She was member of the COP Bureau, the CDM Executive Board and the JISC and has co-chaired negotiating groups on various agenda items at UNFCCC conferences.
