UN4NAPs is a UN-wide partnership initiative, launched in August 2021 by the UNFCCC secretariat, in response to mandates for engaging international organizations in support of climate change adaptation.

UN4NAPs enables a network of 45 UN organizations and intergovernmental organizations to respond to technical requests identified by Least Developed Countries and Small Island Developing States that are in the process of formulating or implementing their National Adaptation Plan (NAP).

Categories of technical assistance offered through the partnership include:

- Direct technical queries, which relevant agencies can answer virtually;
- Delivery of specific data or knowledge products (such as datasets, analytical tools and guidance material);
- Facilitation of integration of adaptation priorities into country support strategies of different agencies and organizations;
- Longer-term technical capacity development through engagement with the requesting country;
- Review of draft NAPs upon request by a country to enhance the coverage of issues and to facilitate subsequent implementation.
