Ambition

- Assessment of NDC progress, align with Net Zero and SDGs
- Build political will and societal ownership
- Strengthen targets, policies, and measures (sectoral)
- Align with existing frameworks NAP, NBSAP, energy compacts, etc.
- Assess costs and investment opportunities

Acceleration

- Drive finance to deliver targets
 - Int'l public: align VF, multilat and bilat
 - Nat'l public: INFFs, bonds, CPEIRs
 - Private: Carbon Markets (HICM offer), private sector coalition
- Integrated technical support on priority areas: Adaptation, Energy, L&D, Nature

- Led groundbreaking work on Just Transition, MRV, Energy and NDC Financing
- Pioneered carbon footprint programme targeting the Private Sector
