





Roles and responsibilities of NDCs Authorities

Reporting capacities and infrastructure to understand past, present and future information

- Past information: historical emissions and reference information.
- **Initial report** (ex ante): describe the authorization, arrangements, describes programmes, emissions and mitigation actions.
- **Annual information** (Article 6 database): report information about quantities, metrics and responsible. Real time data management.
- **Regular information** (BURs- BTRs): Qualitative and quantitative information, including corresponding adjustments.
- **Accounting rules** and NDCs-LTS linkages are key part to understand additionality, permanence **and adaptation contribution** of mitigation actions.

National Attestation/National Authorization/National Reporting





Roles and responsibilities of NDCs Authorities

- 1. Governance and institutional arrangements (NDC Compliance, CORSIA, Art 6, VCM, Domestic Markets)
- **2. Accounting and metrics** (baselines, FREL-avoided emissions, suppressed demand, CDM, REDD+) → Avoid doble counting.
- **3. Legal framework, roles and responsibilities** (NDCs, ownership, safeguards, benefits-distribution mechanisms) > Legal additionality, social and environmental impacts
- Climate finance (financial flows, support for public policy implementation and solve other crisis like biodiversity loss and pollution)
- **4. Permanence, additionality and environmental integrity** (standards, crediting periods, NDC timeframes) → Avoid doble claiming.

Common understanding of compliance, environmental integrity, additionality and permeance
