

Emissions Gap Report

EGR 2023 is the 14th edition in an annual series. The report finds that the world is far off track to limiting global warming.

Only an urgent system-wide transformation can deliver the enormous cuts needed to limit greenhouse gas emissions by 2030: **45%** compared with projections based on policies currently in place to get on track to 1.5°C and 30 per cent for 2°C.

Adaptation Gap Report

AGR 2023 is the 10th edition in an annual series. The report tracks progress in planning, financing and implementing adaptation actions. At least 84 per cent of Parties to the UNFCCC have established adaptation plans, strategies, laws and policies. However, international adaptation finance flows to developing countries are 5-10 times below estimated needs and the gap is widening.







Transparency

- National projects: 21 NCs, 17 BURs, 25 BTRs, 12 CBIT including 34 African countries.
- **4 Transparency Networks:** Anglophone Africa, Francophone, Lusophone Cluster, Middle East and North Africa
- Initiative for Climate Action on Transparency ICAT support for 13 African countries:
 - Phase 3: Mozambique
 - Phase 2: Ghana I Morocco, Zimbabwe
 - Phase 1: **Ethiopia** I Kenya, Guinea I Namibia, Mauritius, Togo I *Algeria, Sierra Leonne, Zambia*

Countries requests to NDC Partnership

- NDC Partnership Action Funds Implementation partners:
 - 3 ongoing activities in Morocco (Increase National Capacities for NDC Investments, Nature-based solutions opportunities, GCF PPF package development),
 - **1 ongoing activity in Malawi** (Greening Malawi's financial sector)
- CAEP Activities (2020) in several countries including Benin,
 Côte d'Ivoire, Morocco, Sudan, Swaziland, Uganda,
 Zimbabwe

NAPs Support

- 22 NAPs are currently under implementation including 11 in Africa Region: Cameroon, Eswatini, Gambia, Ghana, Lesotho, Nigeria, Malawi, Mauritania, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Uganda
- 2 NAPs already completed including the one for Zimbabwe
- NAP Projects are supported through GCF Readiness, except for Rwanda

NDCs & LT LEDS Support

- **Ghana:** Solar Powered Irrigation Systems (SPIS) for smallholder farmers and e-buses implementation.
- **Uganda:** Solar Irrigation, agroforestry and solar dryers and Innovative insurance (PBI) for smallholder farmers.
- **Morocco:** 7 sectors covered in the Long-Term Low Carbon Emission Development Strategy
- Global and regional peer-learning events:
 - UNEA-6 : aligning NDCs and NBSAPs
 - 2024 Africa + West Asia Regional Exchange on NDCs 3.0 with partners (dates tbc)
