NDCs are a way for Government to influence:

- what are the national climate finance priorities and needs need to achieve national and global climate goals
- what constitutes climate finance


Defining your country's conditional and non-conditional commitments is central to securing your climate needs

# Small Climate Finance Ask by Arab States resulted in Limited Climate Finance Flows



- Climate needs and costing were not well articulated by Arab States in the last round of NDCs
- Without a clear ask, donors, banks and investors will presume what are your needs through your NDC narrative.
- A costed list of projects in NDCs helps to direct support to where it is needed

### Arab Climate Finance Strategy

UNFCCC, LAS and ESCWA are supporting the Council of Arab Ministers Responsible for the Environment (CAMRE) though:

- Drafting of an Arab States Climate Finance Access and Mobilization
   Strategy (Arabic and English), which was initiated under the UNFCCC's
   Standing Committee for Finance Needs-based Climate Finance program.
- Needs-based Climate Finance Assessment for Arab States completed
  - Assessment reviewed Arab NDCs and climate strategies, which clearly indicate that Water and Agriculture are the priority areas for intervention by Arab States
  - However, Mitigation constitutes 2/3 of the climate finance needs flowing to Arab States although Adaptation is the region's priority



### Arab Initiative for Mobilizing Climate Finance for Water

Partners: ESCWA, LAS, GCF, IsDB, FAO, Sweden, Arab Fund & ACSAD


- Costing adaptation is harder
- Adaptation also relies more on grants and non-conditional funding
- Easier to cost mitigation measures and even achieve cost recovery
- This should not deter Arab Governments from including Adaptation Commitments in your NDCs or to prepare National Adaptation Plans so that climate finance can also be funneled to adaptation and meet national priority needs.
- Better costing Adaptation is part of the objectives of this joint regional initiative




## Regional Initiative for the Assessment of Climate Change Impacts on Water Resources and Socio-Economic Vulnerability in the Arab Region







### ESCWA Climate Finance Support for Arab States

- Arab Regional Climate Finance Forums: organized by ESCWA and UN High-Level Climate Change Champions (Beirut, 2022; Dubai, 2023).
- Climate/SDGs Debt Swap Initiative: where ESCWA is working with Jordan, Tunisia and others to swap debt for climate action; instrument will be discussed at IMF/WB Annual Meeting event in April 2024.
- Climate mainstreaming in development planning has been an areas work collaboration between ESCWA and IsDB.
- Arab Climate Change Capacity Building Project: by ESCWA and AFESD to help financial institutions and planners to better understand what constitutes Climate and Green Finance in the Arab Region, and to increase access to region-specific data and information.
