The Philippines is considered as one of the most vulnerable countries to climate change. Impacts range from extreme weather events (such as Yolanda and Ondoy), sea level rise, increase in average temperature, charstic changes in rainfall patterns, and drought cas severely affect the country's food security, water sufficiency, human settlements, among

Anchored on the Climate Change Act (CCA) of 2009 and the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP), the Climate Change Expenditure Tagging (CCET) supports maintreaming of climate change adaptation and mitipation into the planning process of local government units (CGU), and provides the starting point from which to measure progress in the implementation of climate change initiatives.

Building on the lessons learned from the national and pilot implementation of the Topging/Tracing Olinate Change Expenditures in the Local Budget for PY 2015, the previously issued Joint Memorandum Circular (EMC) 2014-01 issued by the Department of Budget Management (DBM), Climate Change Commission (CCC), and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DLG) is hereby amended. Amendments to the previously


