# Objectives of the GGA work programme

---

- a) **Enable the full and sustained implementation of the PA, towards achieving the GGA, with a view to enhancing adaptation action and support**
- b) Enhance understanding of the GGA, including of the methodologies, indicators, data and metrics, needs and support needed for assessing progress towards it
- c) Contribute to reviewing the overall progress made in achieving the GGA as part of the GST
- d) **Enhance national planning and implementation of adaptation actions through the process to formulate and implement NAPs and through NDCs and adaptation communications**
- e) Enable Parties to better communicate their adaptation priorities, implementation and support needs, plans and actions
- f) Facilitate the establishment of robust, nationally appropriate systems for monitoring and evaluating adaptation actions
- g) **Strengthen implementation of adaptation actions in vulnerable developing countries**
- h) Enhance understanding of how communication and reporting instruments established under the Convention and the PA related to adaptation can complement each other in order to avoid duplication of efforts.



# Overview of relevant Paris Agreement provisions

---

- Adaptation is a global challenge faced by all with local, subnational, national, regional and international dimensions (Art.7.2)
- The adaptation efforts of developing country Parties shall be recognized (Art.7.3)
- Parties should strengthen their cooperation on enhancing action on adaptation, including regarding sharing of information, good practices, experiences and lessons learned; strengthening institutional arrangements; strengthening scientific knowledge on climate; assisting developing country Parties in identifying effective adaptation practices, adaptation needs, priorities, support provided and received for adaptation actions and efforts and improving the effectiveness and durability of adaptation actions (Art.7.7)
- Each Party shall, as appropriate, engage in adaptation planning processes and the implementation of actions, which may include the NAP process, assessment of climate change impacts and vulnerability and building the resilience of socioeconomic and ecological systems (Art.7.9)
- Continuous and enhanced international support shall be provided to developing country Parties (Art.7.13)



# Overview of the workshop

---

- As of 29 August 2022, a total of 14 submissions from Groups of Parties, Parties and observers were made on the second workshop and are reflected in the concept note
- Four thematic blocks each with three break-out groups:
  - Enhancing adaptation planning and implementation
  - Enabling conditions
  - Enhancing adaptation support
  - Adequacy and effectiveness of adaptation action and support
- Reporting back from groups in plenary sessions
